Ano Europeu da Igualdade de Oportunidades para Todos: parceiro oficial do Festival Eurovisão da Canção de 2007



O Ano Europeu da Igualdade de Oportunidades para Todos - 2007 tem o prazer de anunciar que será parceiro oficial do Festival Eurovisão da Canção de 2007. Pela primeira vez em quase 20 anos, uma iniciativa oficial da União Europeia estará associada a este concurso internacional de música, juntando europeus de todo o continente. Os principais objectivos do Ano Europeu são celebrar as vantagens da diversidade e promover a igualdade de oportunidades para todos.

Vladimír Špidla, o Comissário Europeu para o Emprego, os Assuntos Sociais e a Igualdade de Oportunidades, declarou: «O Festival Eurovisão da Canção constitui um espaço ideal para informar os cidadãos sobre os seus direitos em matéria de igualdade de tratamento e para divulgar as vantagens da diversidade por toda a Europa. Que melhor enquadramento poderíamos desejar que uma espectacular manifestação à escala europeia que reúne as diversas culturas e sabores da Europa na sua totalidade?»

A legislação antidiscriminação da UE é uma das mais avançadas do mundo. Ainda assim, só um terço dos cidadãos europeus conhece os seus direitos no caso de vir a ser vítima de discriminação. Entretanto, 64% desses mesmos cidadãos europeus consideram que a discriminação é muito comum nos respectivos países e 51% pensam que não se está a lutar suficientemente contra a discriminação.

Durante a semana do Festival da Eurovisão, que terá lugar no centro de Helsínquia entre 5 e 12 de Maio, a campanha do Ano Europeu promoverá as suas mensagens a partir de um pavilhão no espaço dedicado ao festival. Esse stand fornecerá aos visitantes informações sobre igualdade e diversidade e acolherá uma série de actividades de diversão. O Ano Europeu fará igualmente chegar a sua mensagem aos 2 000 jornalistas que se espera assistam à manifestação, através de um stand promocional instalado na sala de imprensa da Eurovisão.

As actividades do Ano Europeu na Eurovisão concentrar-se-ão particularmente no Dia da Europa, quarta-feira 9 de Maio. Será prestada especial atenção aos jovens, proporcionando-lhes uma oportunidade de revelar os seus talentos na área do canto e da dança.

O Ano Europeu de 2007 centra-se na discriminação relacionada com sexo, raça ou origem étnica, religião ou convicções, deficiência, idade ou orientação sexual. Todas estas formas de discriminação podem ser tratadas no âmbito da legislação europeia.

Festival Eurovisão da Canção

Desde a sua primeira difusão em 1956, o Festival Eurovisão da Canção tornou-se uma tradição europeia de eleição, atingindo uma audiência de cerca de 100 milhões de europeus e um público ainda mais vasto que o dos 42 países participantes. Seguindo a tradição de realizar o festival no país de origem da canção vencedora no ano anterior, o 52.º Festival Eurovisão da Canção realizar-se-á em Helsínquia, na Finlândia, país de proveniência da banda Lordi, que saiu vencedora em 2006.
